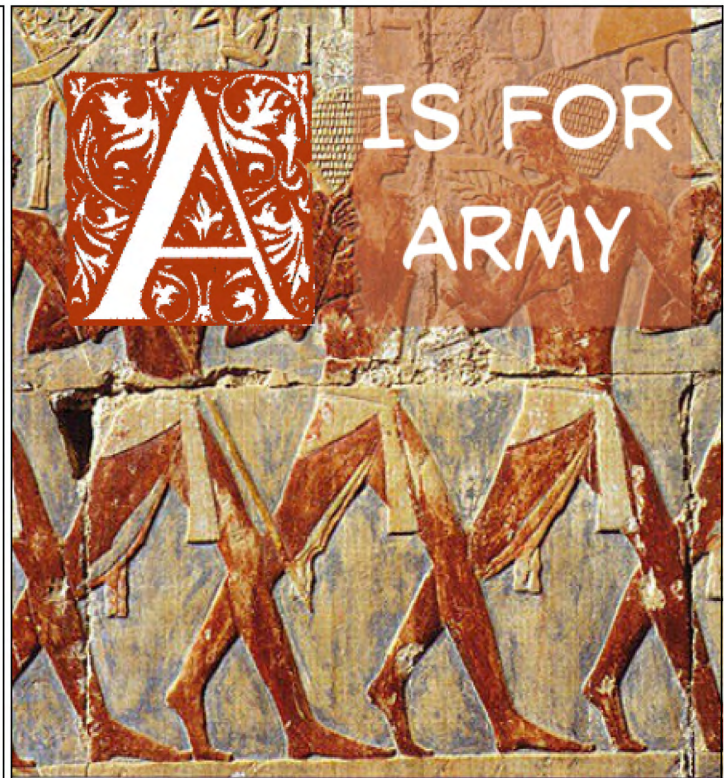

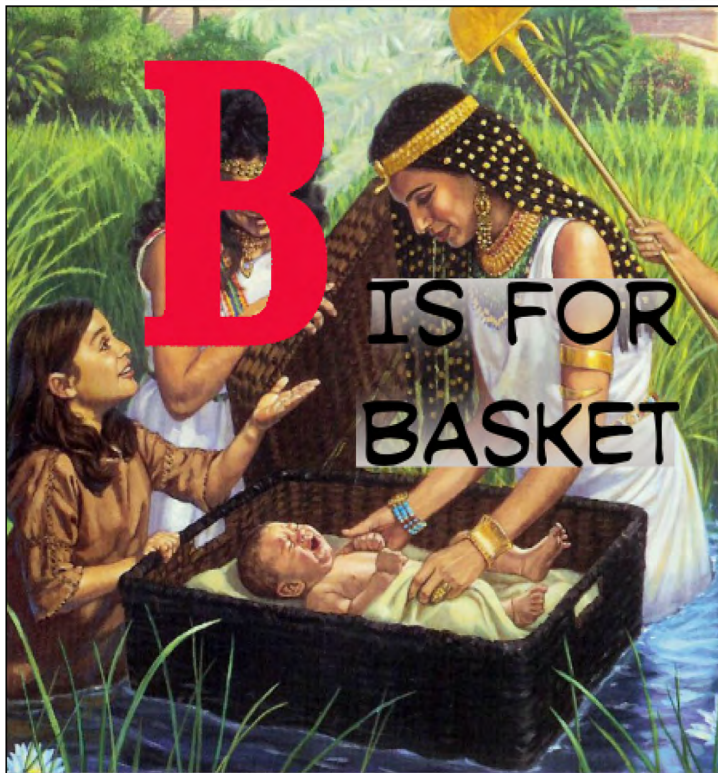

Moses Killed an Egyptian and buried his corpse in the sand. (2:12)

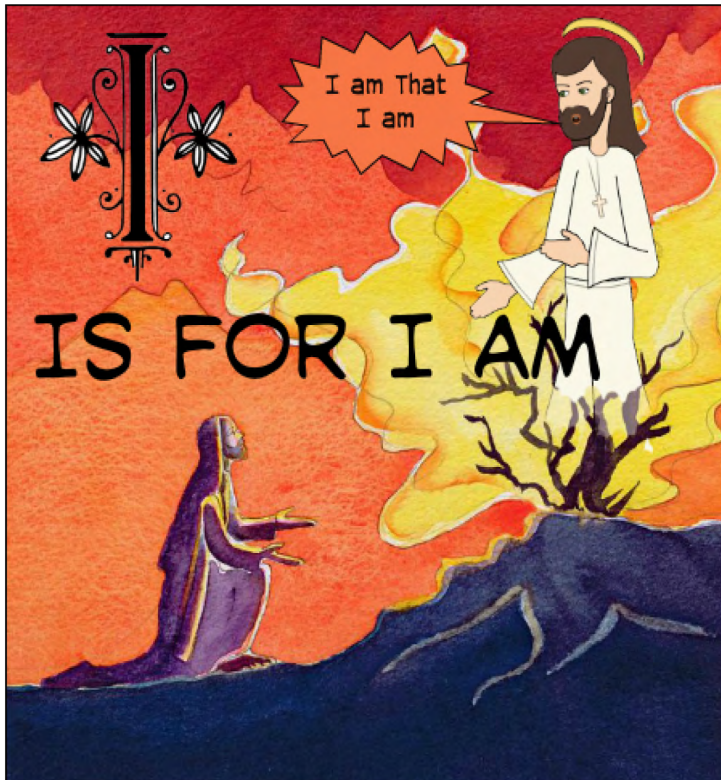


IS FOR ZIPPORAH

Jethro gave his daughter Zipporah to Moses. They named their son Gershom (2:21)

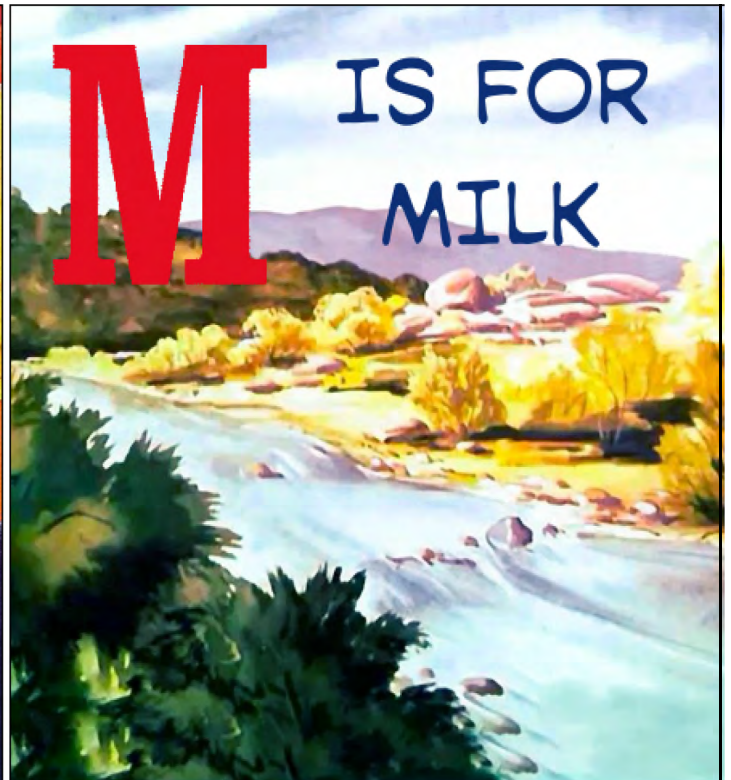


IS FOR I AM

## IS FOR LAND

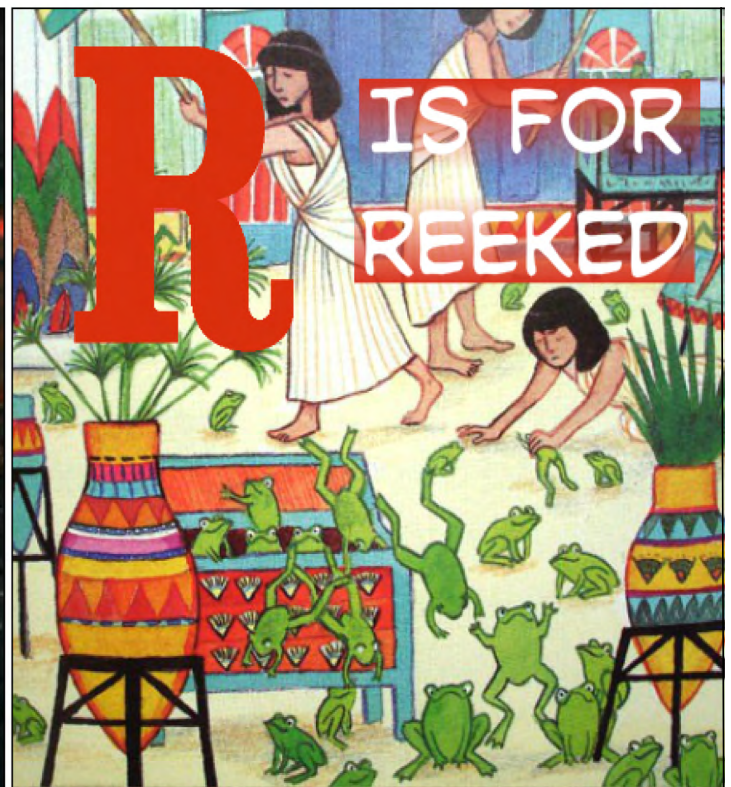


I will bring you to a land I swore with an uplifted hand to give to you. (6:8)

Total darkness covered all Egypt for three days. No one could see anyone else or move about (10:22)

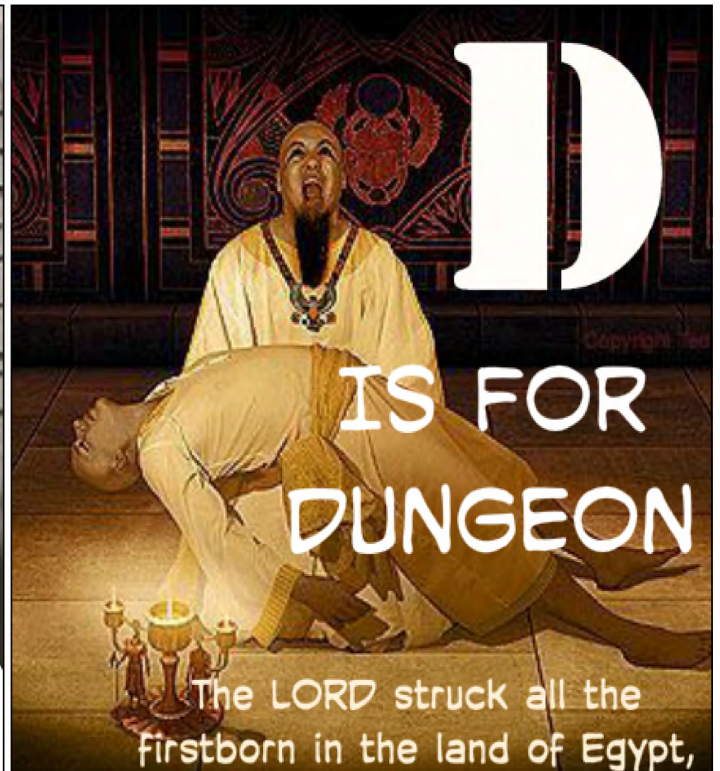


IS FOR LINTEL
