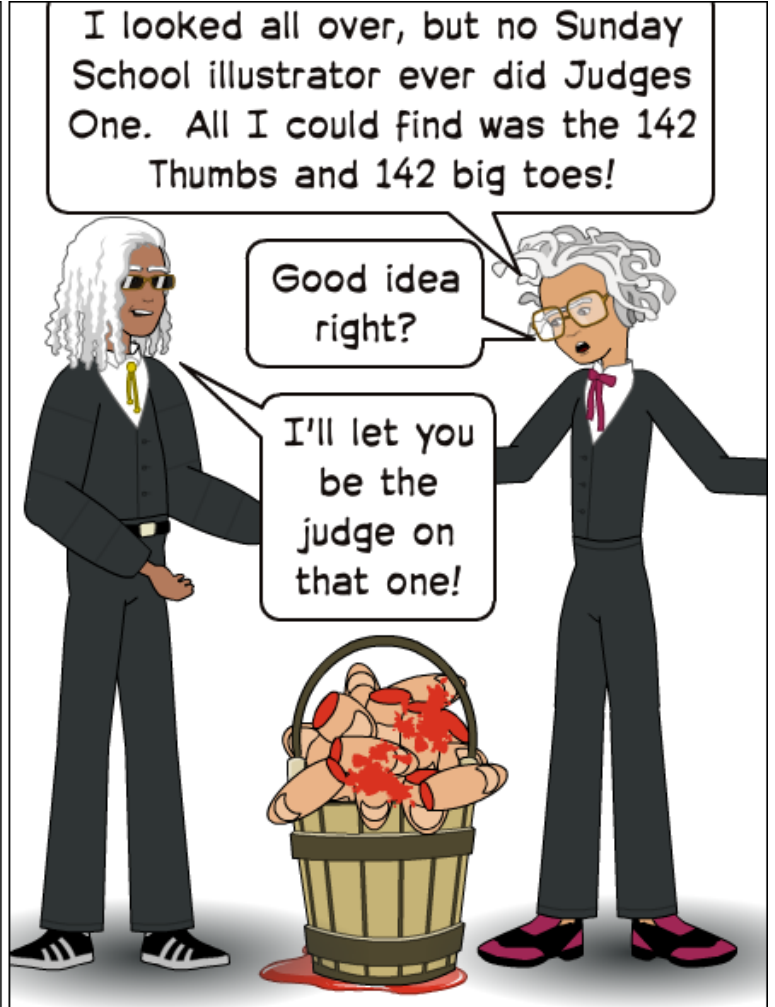

The Benjaminites did not drive out the Jebusites who were living in Jerusalem.



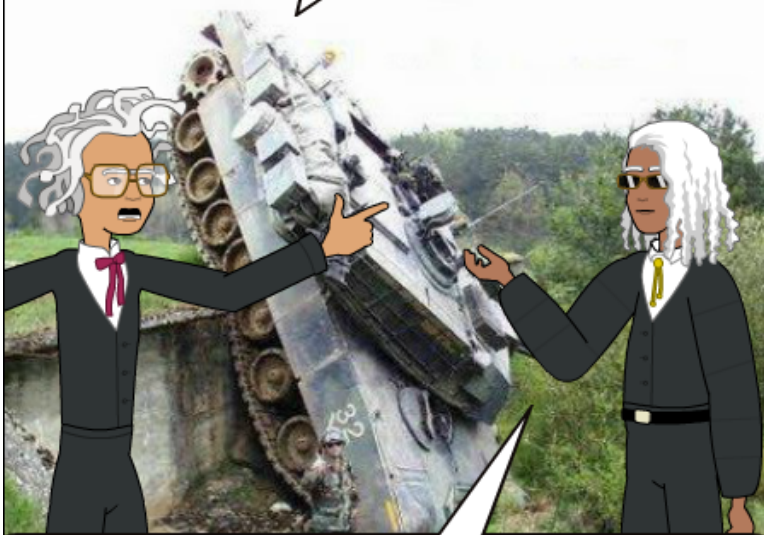
The Jebusites have lived among the Benjaminites in Jerusalem to this day.

They forsook the LORD, and served Baal and the Ashtaroth.

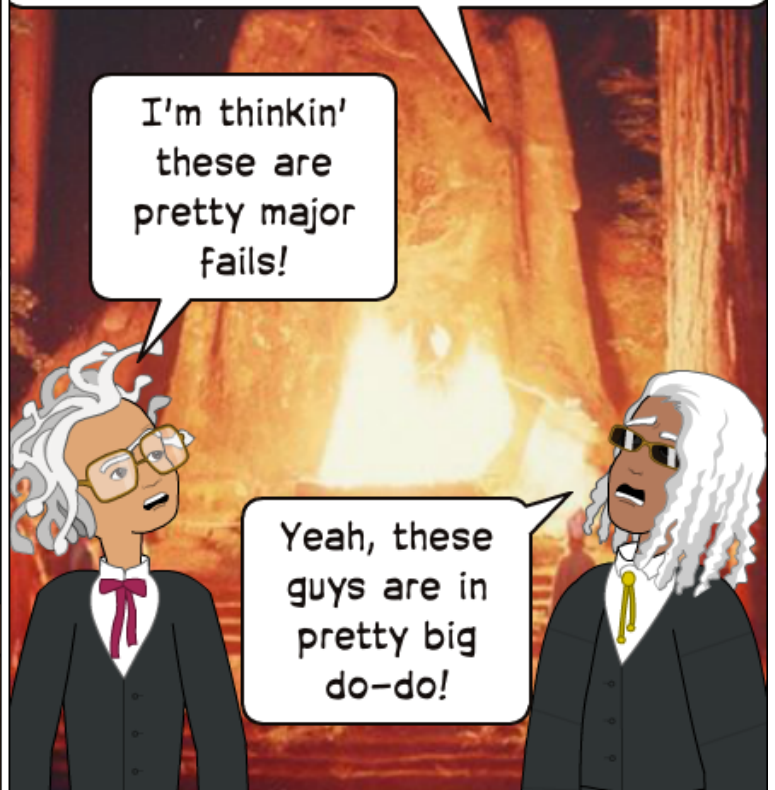
Whoops, I don't think this is going to turn out so good!

Yeah, these guys are in pretty big do-do!

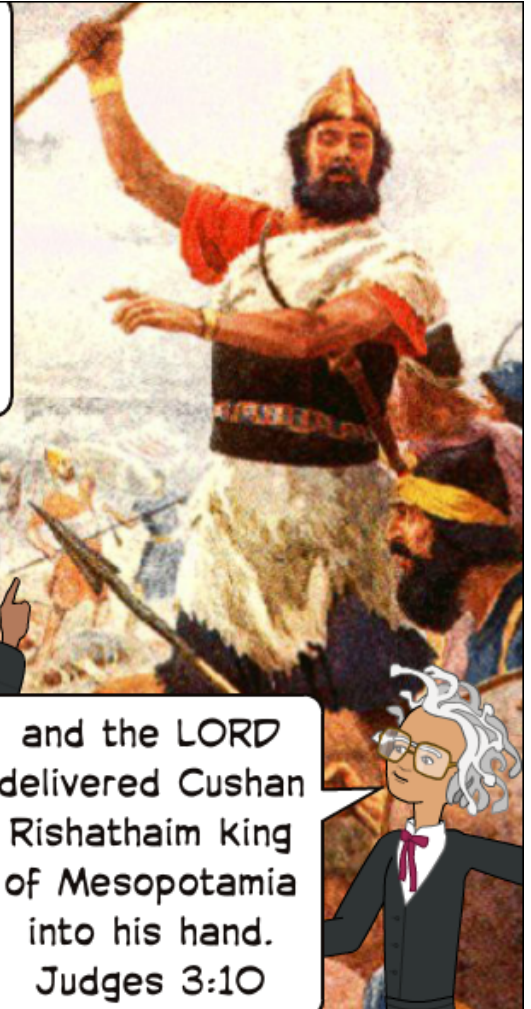
The children of Israel lived among the Canaanites, the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites:

and the LORD delivered Cushan Rishathaim King of Mesopotamia into his hand. Judges 3:10

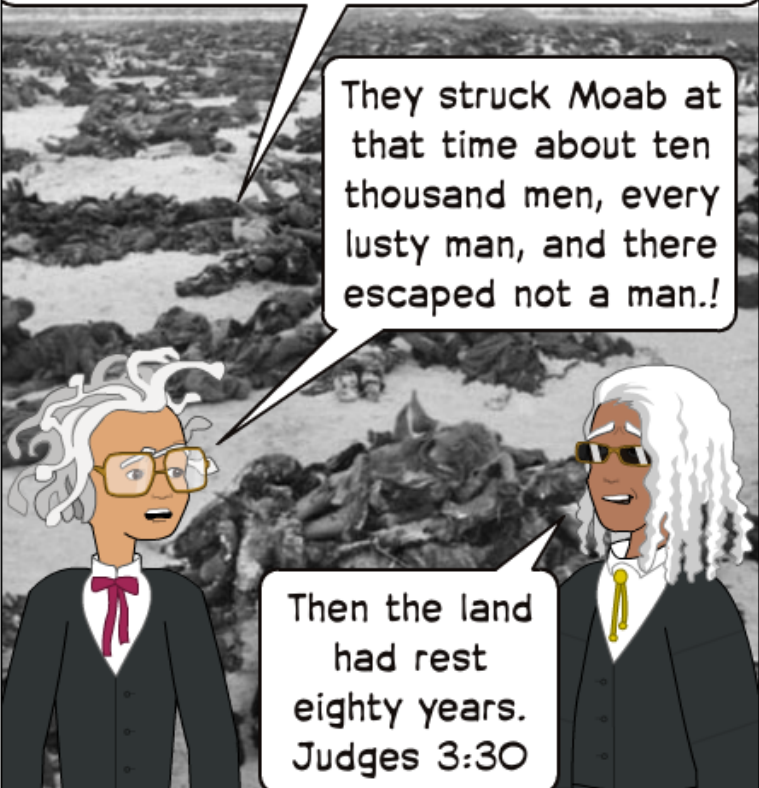


Eglon, you're a fat man and I've got a secret message for you. Here, taste my blade!

Ehud said to them, "Follow after me; for the LORD has delivered your enemies the Moabites into your hand." Judges 3:28



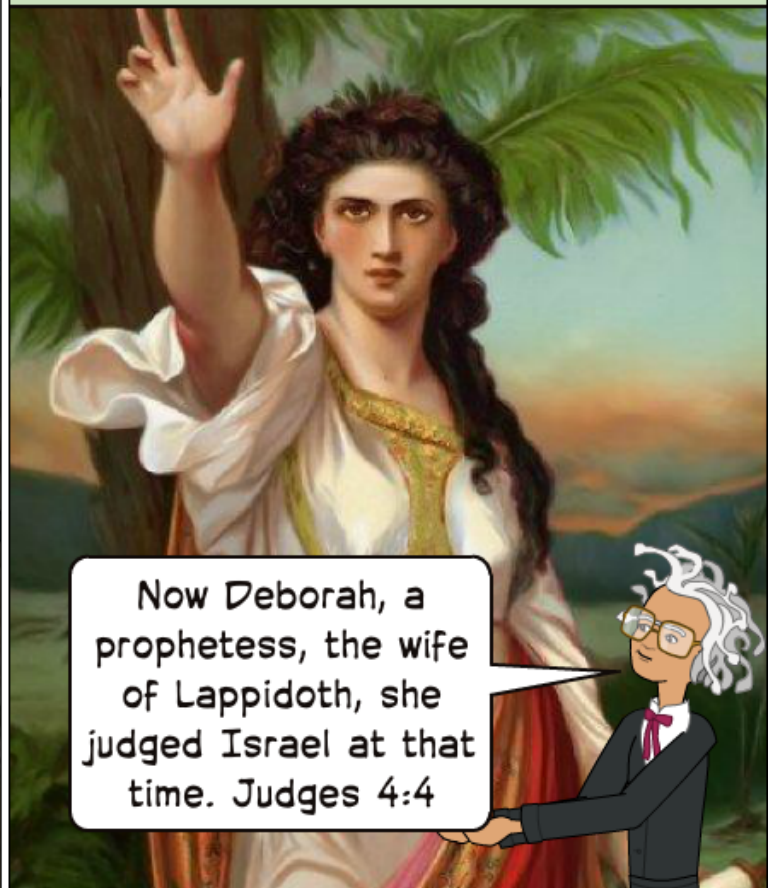
They struck Moab at that time about ten thousand men, every lusty man, and there escaped not a man.!

The angel of the LORD came, and sat under the oak which was in Ophrah

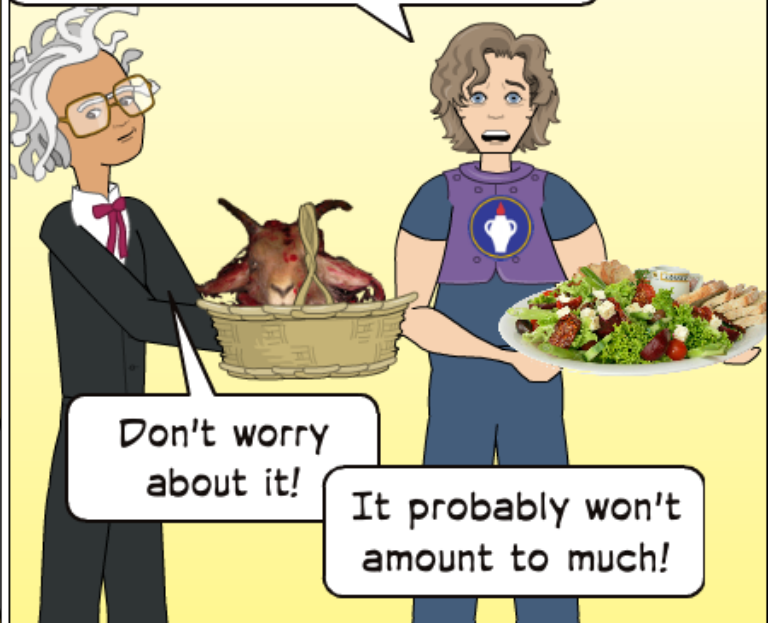


The LORD is with you, mighty warrior

I think this is going to be famous someday!



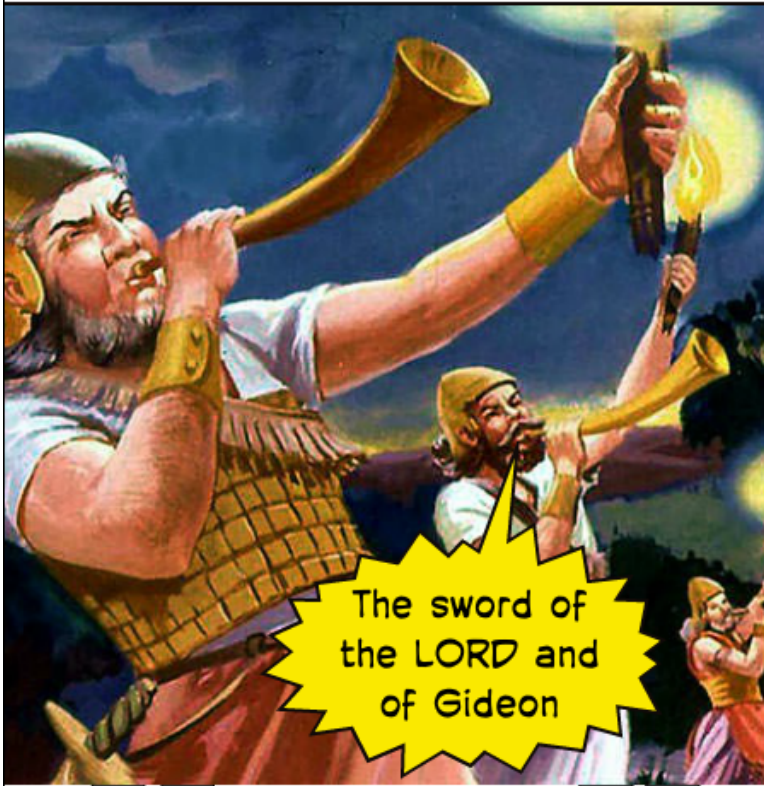

Judges 7:25

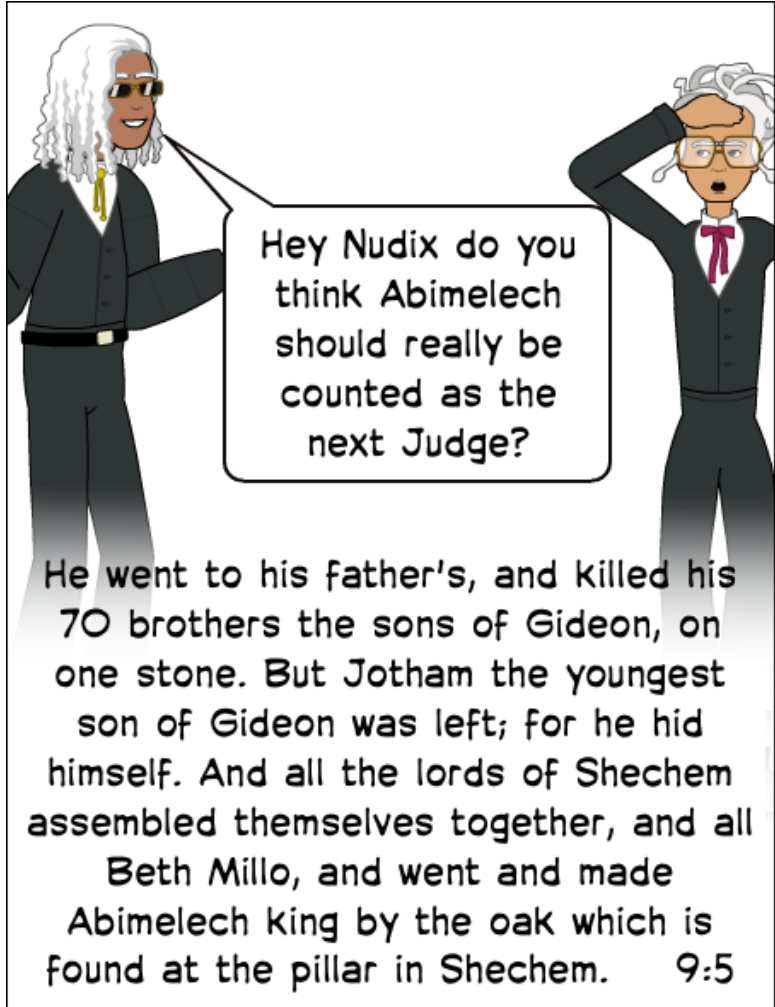

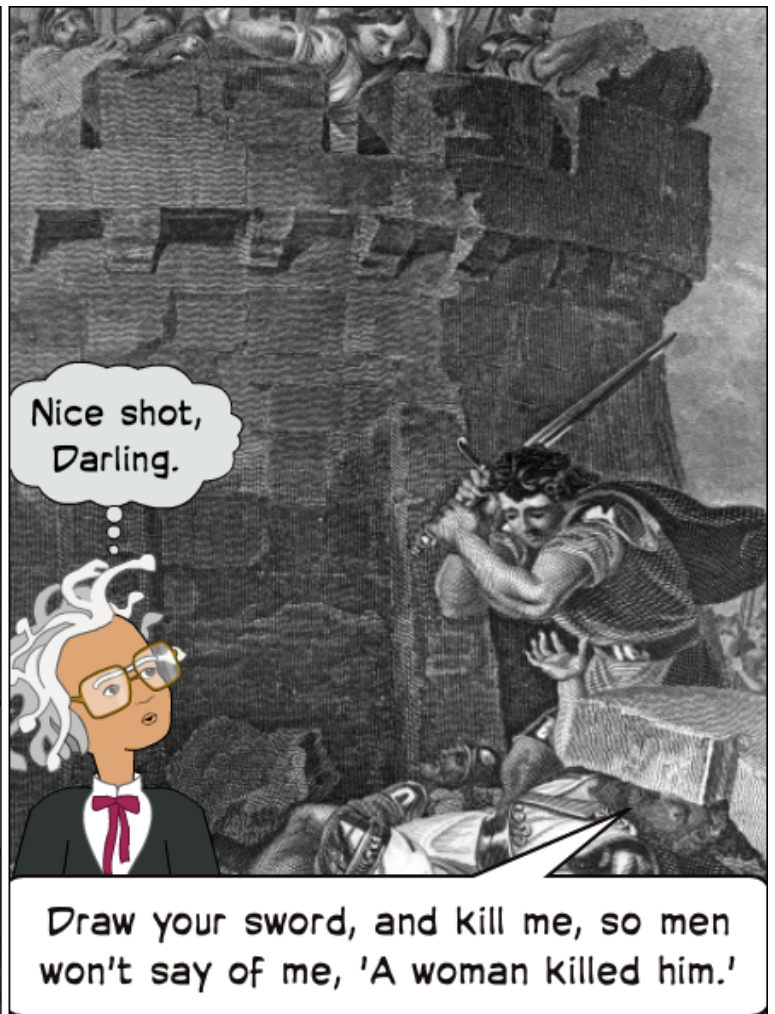
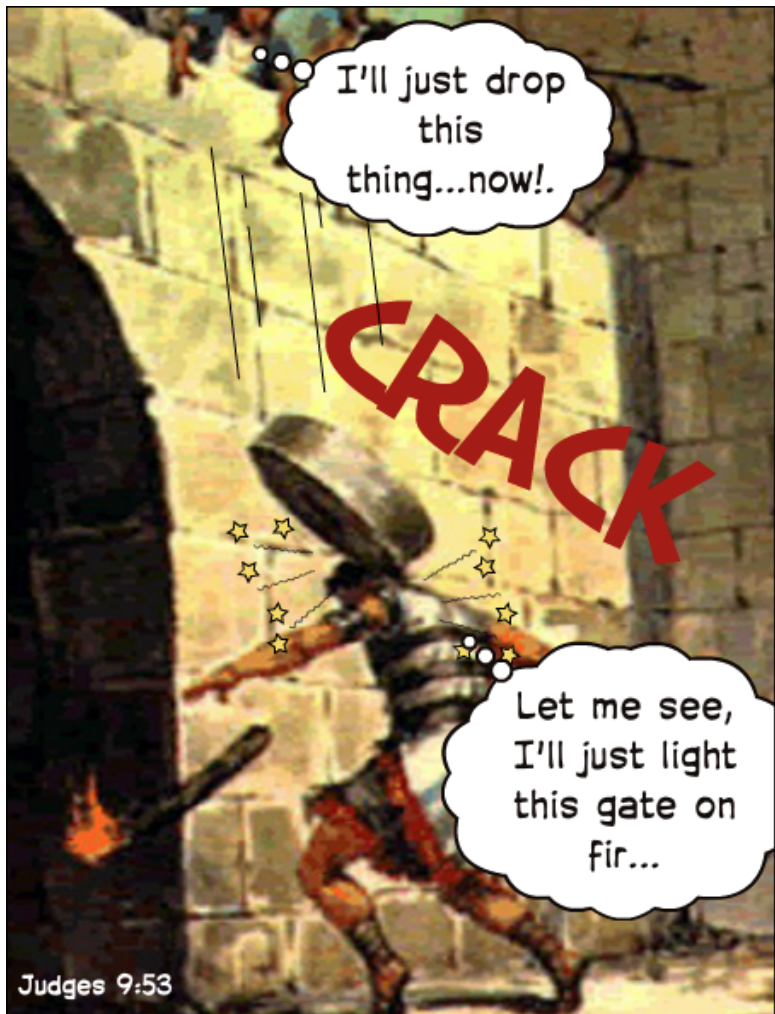


Gideon had seventy sons for he had many wives Judges 8:30

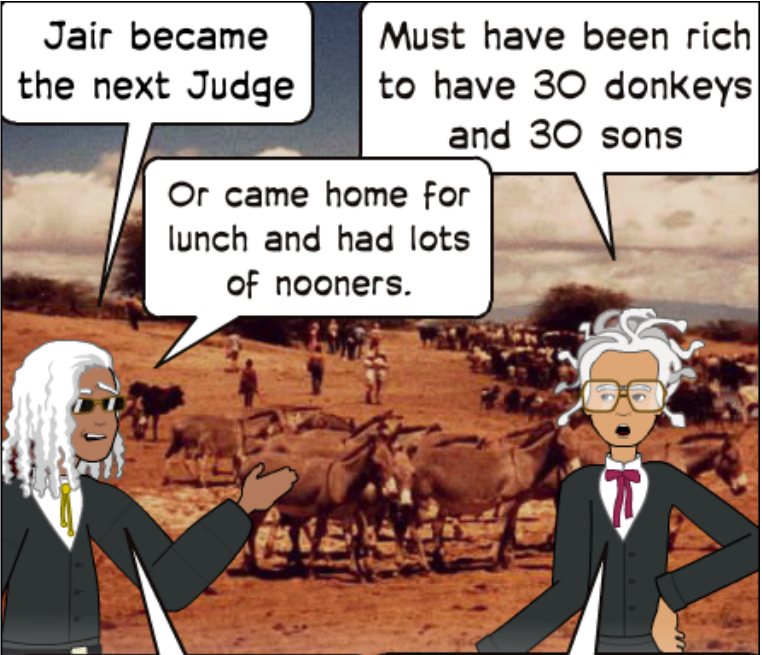






Tola, the grandson of Dodo became the next Judge

Must have been rich to have 30 donkeys and 30 sons

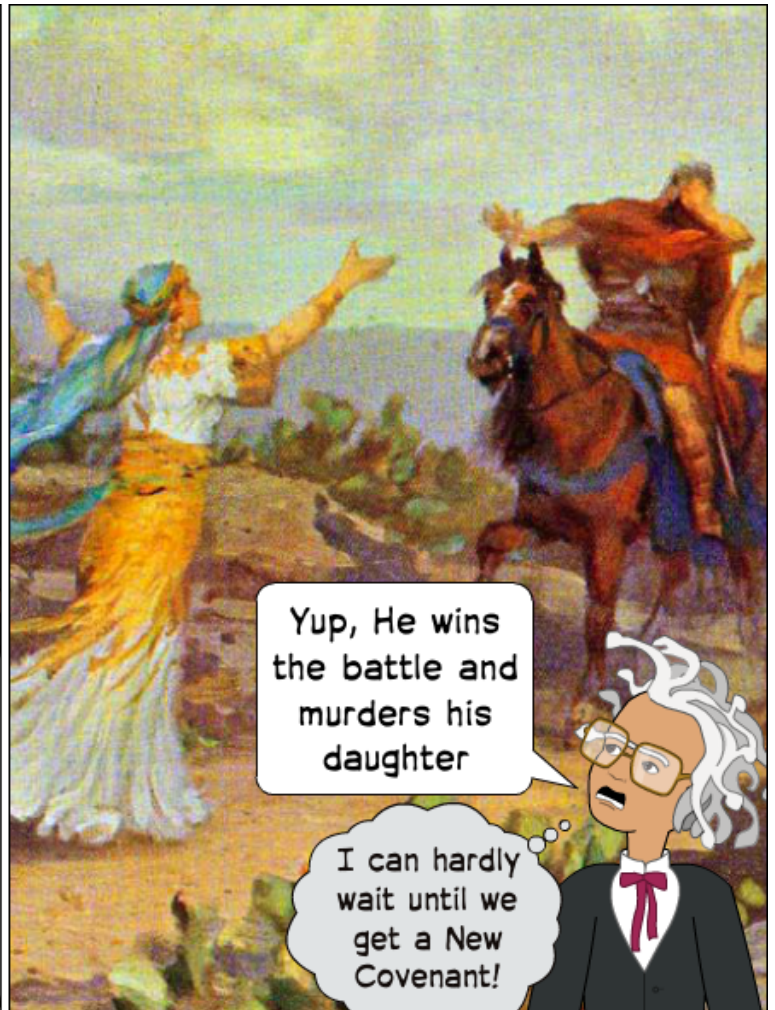
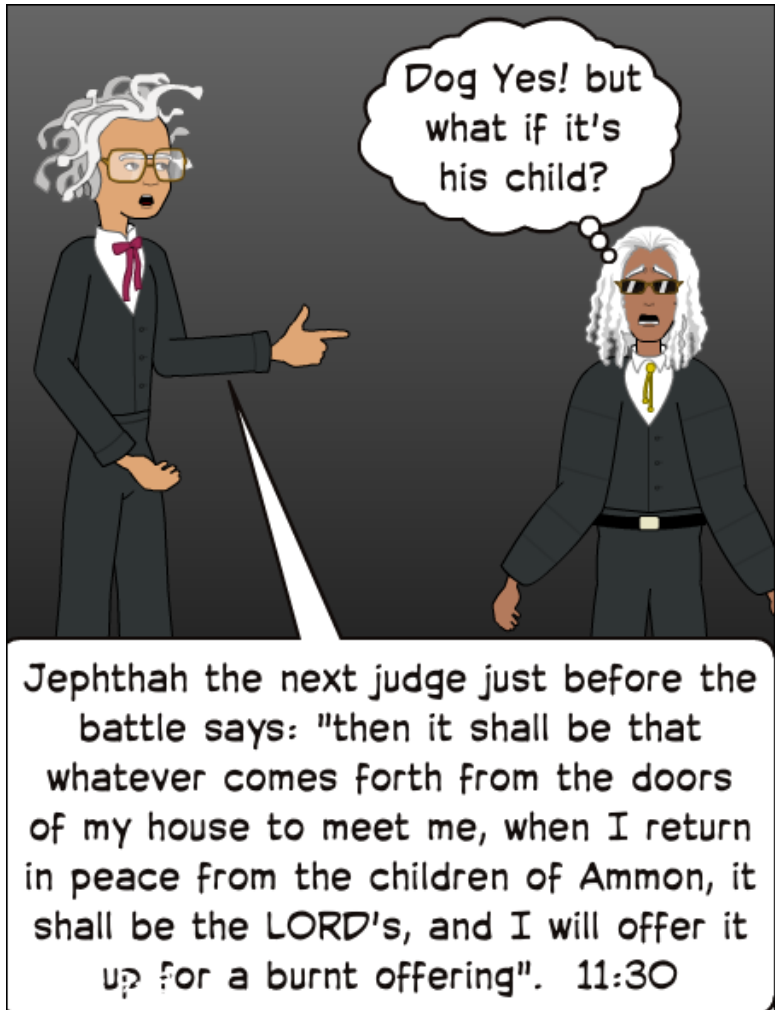
Or came home for lunch and had lots of nooners.

They could have Addiction 12 Step programs and Bingo Nights!

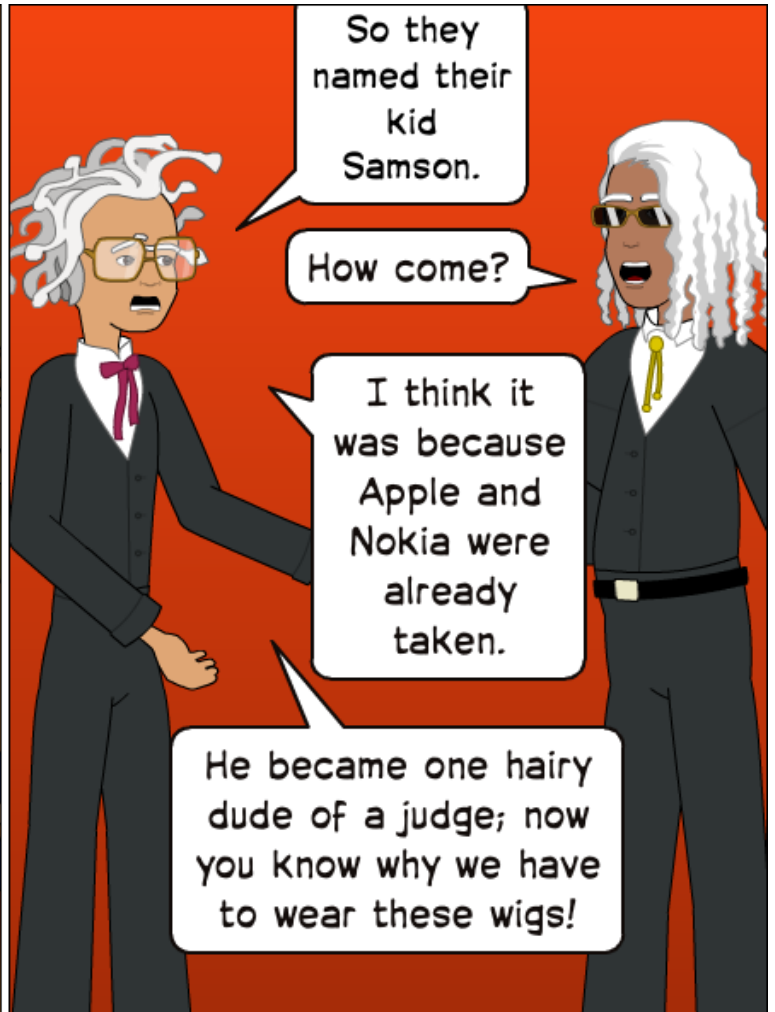
Why if it was fun then the surrounding nations would want to be like them!

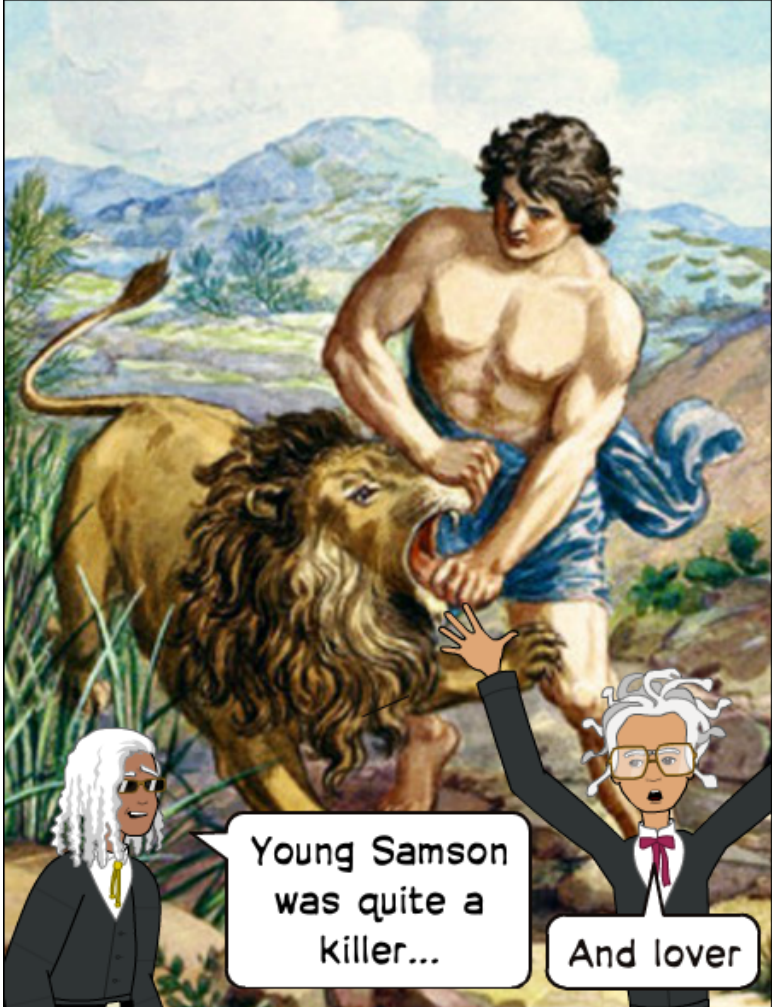
You mean those Kenites, Hittites and Excredimities!

But wait; Samson is about to be born, things will surely turn around!

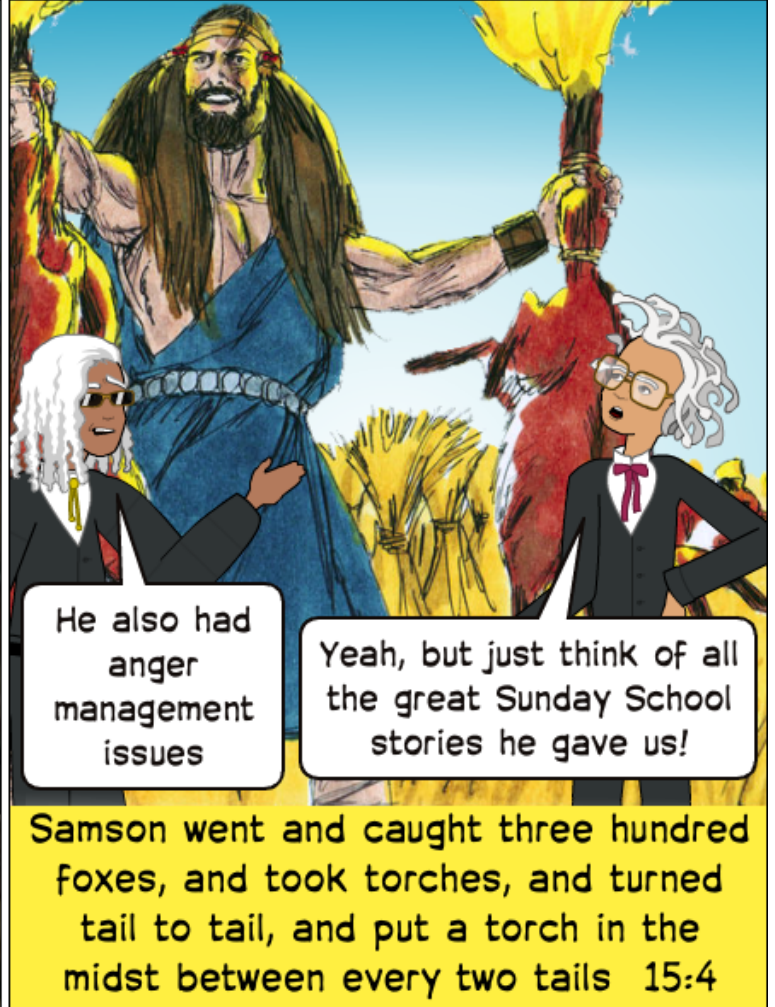






Young Samson was quite a killer...

Samson went and caught three hundred foxes, and took torches, and turned tail to tail, and put a torch in the midst between every two tails 15:4



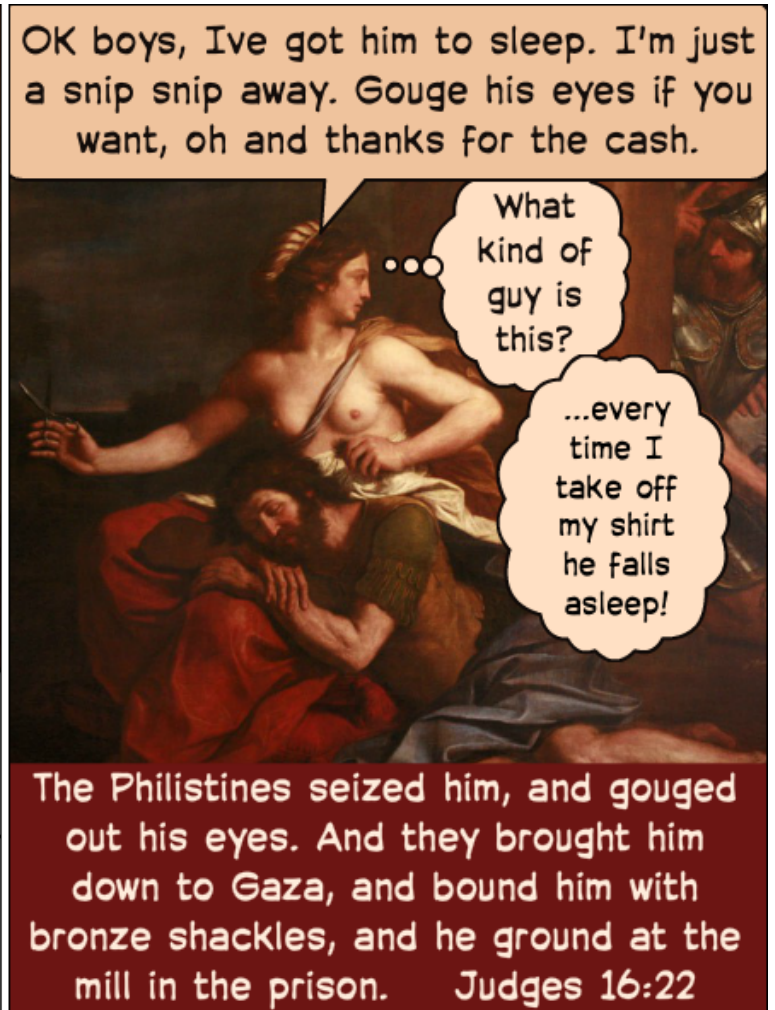


Hey Babe, I need to know where your great strength comes from?
