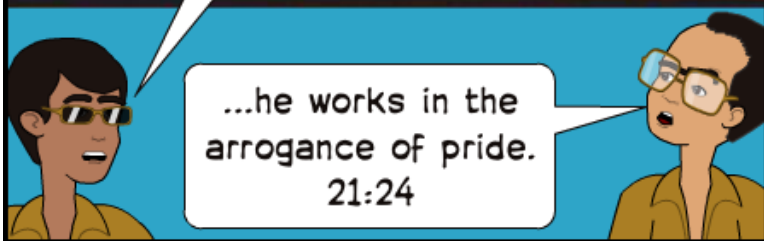


Get out of my way buddy, I'm in front!

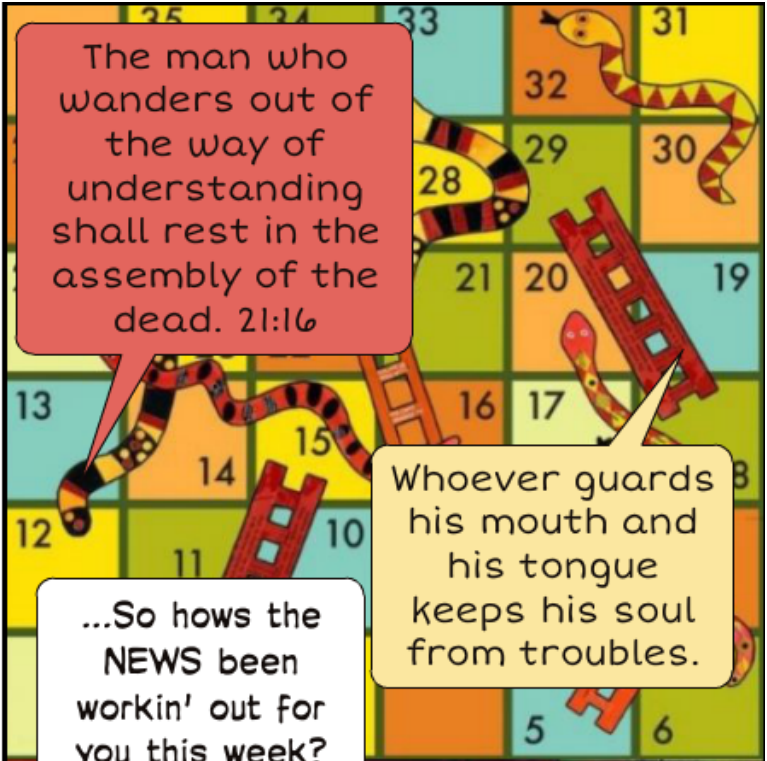

The proud and haughty man, "scoffer" is his name...



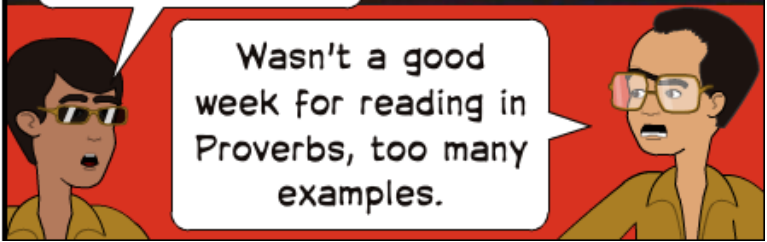

A fool will never attain wisdom on Facebook.

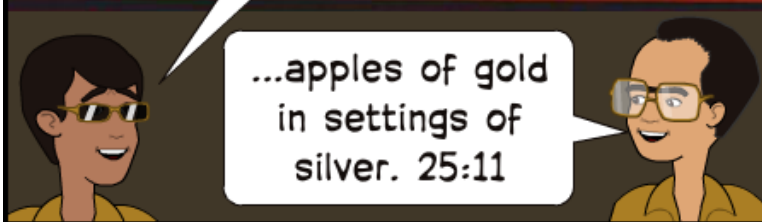
If you hang out with wicked facebook friends, disaster will come eventually.

Eat raw, local facebook honey.

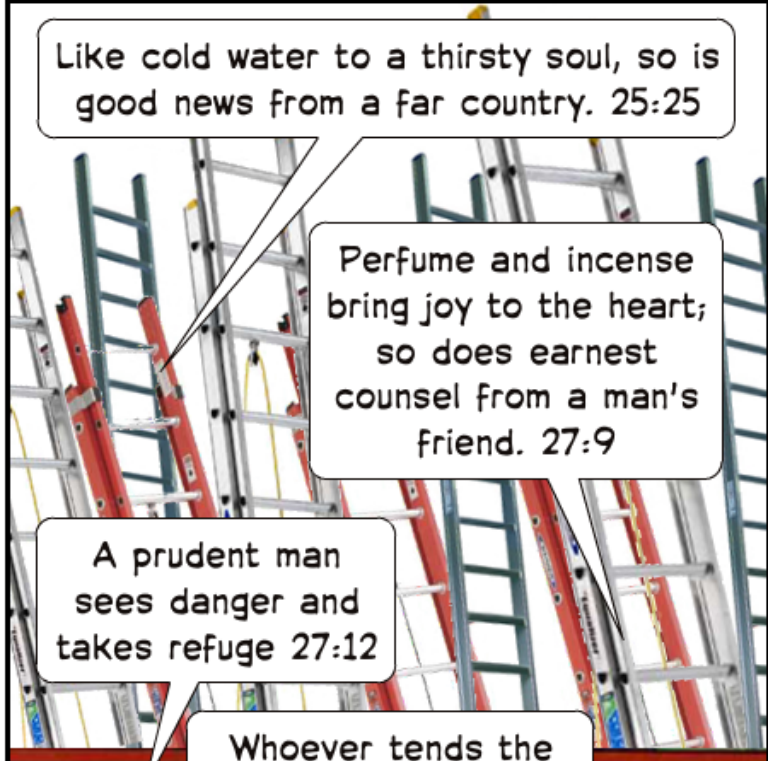
